14 DAYS OF GRACE EXPLOSION

THEME:

JESUS

- You may have fleeting hunger pains or dizziness.
- Withdrawal from caffeine and sugar may cause headaches.
- Physical annoyances may also include weakness, tiredness, or sleeplessness.

The first two or three days are usually the hardest. As you continue to fast, you will likely experience a sense of well-being both physically and spiritually. However, should you feel hunger pains, increase your liquid intake.

STEP 4: Put Yourself on a Schedule

For maximum spiritual benefit, set aside time to be alone with the Lord. Listen for His leading. The more time you spend with Him, the more meaningful your fast will be.

Morning

- Begin your day in praise and worship.
- Read and meditate on God's Word.
- Invite the Holy Spirit to work in you.
- Invite God to use you.
- Pray for His vision for your life and empowerment to do His will.

Afternoon

- Return to prayer and God's Word.
- Take a short prayer walk.

Evening

- When possible, begin and end each day on your knees for a brief time of praise and thanksgiving to God.

STEP 5: End Your Fast Gradually

Break Your Fast

First of all drink water; if possible warm water or beverage to help the digestive track to relax. After that, you should start off with something light to eat such as fruit; namely bananas or apples. Do not break your fast with fruits such as oranges due to their high acidic content. The fast for each day will end at 6pm.

STEP 6: Expect Results

If you sincerely humble yourself before the Lord, repent, pray, and seek God's face; if you consistently meditate on His Word, you will experience a heightened awareness of His presence (John 14:21). The Lord will give you fresh, new spiritual insights. Your confidence and faith in God will be strengthened. You will feel mentally, spiritually and physically refreshed.

Fasting teaches us spiritual discipline. Many great people in the Bible fasted and saw God move in miraculous ways among them, from Daniel to Esther to Paul and even Jesus. It teaches us spiritual discipline.

Jesus said to the disciples in Matthew 6:16: "When you fast...". This implies that as believers, fasting is a part of our walk with God. If you sincerely humble yourself before God, repent, pray and meditate on His Word, you'll experience a heightened awareness of His presence (John 14:21). You'll feel mentally, spiritually and physically refreshed.

DAY 1 Personal Awakening/Acknowledging the Holy Spirit

Exalt God for who He is—the Mighty God, the Great I AM, the Creator of the heavens and the earth; all things exist by His command and power. (Genesis 1:1; Isaiah 9:6; Exodus 3:14)

Praise God for His incomparable strength, for there is no god in heaven or on earth who can do the mighty works He does; He is the Alpha and the Omega. (Deuteronomy 3:24; Revelation 1:8)

Thank God for the gift of salvation, freely given through His grace and secured forever in Christ; by this we have become His children and He our Father. (John 1:12; Ephesians 2:8; Romans 8:15)

Thank God for the gift of life to see 2026, for preservation, breath, purpose, and the privilege to walk in His plans for this new year. (Psalm 118:24; Lamentations 3:22-23; Acts 17:28)

Thank God for His word concerning this house for 2026—our year of the Spirit and Faith; He is not a man that He should lie, and His word will surely be fulfilled among us. (Numbers 23:19; Habakkuk 2:3; Romans 10:17)

Father, thank You for watching over my family and loved ones, for Your hand of protection, provision, and peace as we enter 2026. (Psalm 91:1-2; Isaiah 54:17)

Thank God for the vision and visionary leadership of EWG Global, for Senior Pastors Apostle Justice & Rev. Patience Kwawu, whom You have appointed for such a time as this. (Jeremiah 3:15; Hebrews 13:7)

Thank God for the gift of the Holy Spirit, for this year we are not alone; we walk in light, truth, and divine guidance in every situation. (John 14:16-17; John 16:13)

Declare that in 2026 we walk boldly in faith, producing results, bearing fruit, and manifesting the realities of the Spirit in every area of our lives. (2 Corinthians 5:7; Galatians 5:22-23; Hebrews 11:6)

DAY 2 Holy Spirit/Receiving the Power of the Spirit

Thank God for the gift of the Holy Spirit in your life. Declare that you are yielded to the Holy Spirit in all you do—your thoughts, words, and actions are submitted to His leadership. (John 14:16-17; Romans 8:14)

Pray that by the Holy Spirit who works in you, you draw on divine grace to live a disciplined and consecrated life that continually hosts His presence. (Philippians 2:13; Galatians 2:20; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

Ask God to make you a suitable vessel for the Holy Spirit, prepared and sanctified for His use, that signs and wonders may flow through you and through the church. (2 Timothy 2:20-21; Mark 16:17-18; Acts 5:12)

Pray for the fire of the Holy Spirit to burn continually in your heart, producing an unquenchable and unconquerable zeal for God and His purposes. (Romans 12:11; Jeremiah 20:9; 1 Thessalonians 5:19)

Declare that your spirit dominates your flesh, and that by the Holy Spirit you walk in victory over sinful desires and carnal patterns. (Galatians 5:16-17; Romans 8:10-13)

Pray that the Holy Spirit will lead you into all truth, giving you clarity, discernment, and divine direction in every decision you make. (John 16:13; Isaiah 30:21)

Declare that through the Holy Spirit you bear lasting fruit, reflecting the character and nature of Christ in every area of your life. (Galatians 5:22-23; John 15:8)

Declare that by the Holy Spirit in you, this year 2026 you produce excellence in all you do; therefore understanding, divine insight, and the ability to bring solutions and interpret mysteries rest upon you. (Daniel 5:12; Daniel 6:3)

Pray that the Holy Spirit indwelling you manifests His seven-fold operations in your life — the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, causing you to make accurate decisions and positioning you for favor and increase this year; the Spirit of counsel and might, working powerfully in you so that you overcome and prevail in every situation; and the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, enabling you to walk in obedience, spiritual sensitivity, and reverence that continually attracts God's pleasure. (Isaiah 11:2; James 1:5)

Pray that you surrender your heart, plans, and decisions fully to the Holy Spirit. You are led by Him in all things, and you walk in clarity and discernment. By the abundant supply of the Spirit this year, you experience progressive fruitfulness in my life, my family, and this ministry. (Romans 8:14; Isaiah 32:15; Galatians 5:18)



DAY 3 Wisdom/Yielding to the Spirit's Guidance 1/2

Declare that God's wisdom is working mightily in you. You excel in good judgment; have the right ideas and make the right decisions at all times. You are filled with the knowledge of God's will, in all wisdom and spiritual understanding. You do not walk in confusion or uncertainty, for God orders your steps by His Word and Spirit. (Colossians 1:9; Proverbs 3:5-6)

Affirm that I know who I am—the seed of Abraham, an heir according to the promise. Declare that you reign and rule over circumstances by the power of the Greater One who lives in you. There is no failure in your path and no defeat in your journey; you move from glory to glory and from success to success. (Galatians 3:29; 1 John 4:4; 2 Corinthians 3:18)

Pray that by your fellowship with the Holy Spirit, God's glory and eternal purposes are revealed to you. You bring forth good things from within you, for you carry divine treasure to bless the world. The wisdom of God is actively guiding and showing you the way you should go. (Isaiah 48:17; Matthew 12:35)

Affirm that Christ has been made your wisdom; therefore, you conduct all your affairs with prudence, discretion, and excellence. You have insight into mysteries and secrets, and hidden things are revealed to you by the Spirit of wisdom. (1 Corinthians 1:30; Daniel 2:22)

Pray that daily, you are guided by God's wisdom, and His infallible truth is your meditation and delight. Declare that you possess all that you require for a joyful, successful, and victorious life. You carry an excellent spirit, and therefore you produce excellent results in all that you do. (Psalm 1:2-3; Daniel 6:3)

Affirm that the Holy Spirit is at work in you; both to will and to do according to God's perfect pleasure. By His superabundant grace, you function with divine precision and consistency. (Philippians 2:13; 2 Corinthians 9:8)

Pray that you have divine insight, inspiration, motivation, and the ability to conceive and execute God-inspired ideas that bring transformation to your world. You are an heir of God and a joint heir with Christ; a blesser, a giver, and a carrier of divine impact. (Romans 8:17; Isaiah 60:1)

Thank God for revealing His wisdom to you through His Word. Declare that His Word in your heart makes you wise, fruitful, and excellent. Your life moves from glory to glory. Out of your innermost being, you bring forth good things continually. (Psalm 19:7; John 7:38)

Declare that my life is for glory and beauty; in your path there is life, success, victory, and abundance. You are the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus—holy, sanctified, flourishing, stable, durable, and fruitful in Jesus' Name. (Proverbs 4:18; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Psalm 92:12-14)

Declare that the wisdom of God causes you to move in the right direction. You refuse to be drowned in deceit, confusion, or distractions. Your eyes are fixed on Christ alone, and you walk confidently in divine direction. (James 1:5; Hebrews 12:2)



DAY 4 Wisdom/Yielding to the Spirit's Guidance 2/2

Pray that God provokes supernatural multiplication upon every seed of commitment and labour you have sown—causing every sacrifice, service, and investment to yield abundant harvest. (Genesis 26:12; 2 Corinthians 9:6-8)

Ask that God prospers every member of EWG Global abundantly all year round, supplying every need and causing grace to abound in all things; opening doors of access, influence, and relevance. (Psalm 1:3; 3 John 1:2)

Pray for the ongoing and increased miraculous manifestation of EWG Global events, that God's power, presence, and glory are revealed at higher dimensions. (Acts 5:12; Isaiah 60:1)

Thank God for the rich and beautiful life He has brought you into in Christ, acknowledging your inheritance where all things are freely given for your enjoyment. (John 10:10; Ephesians 1:3)

Thank God for creating you in His image and likeness, declaring that you are His peculiar treasure and a vessel fashioned for beauty, glory, and good works. (Genesis 1:26; 1 Peter 2:9; Ephesians 2:10)

Thank God for granting you insight into the mysteries and secrets of the Kingdom, declaring that you are filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding. (Colossians 1:9; Daniel 2:22)

Thank God for enlightening the eyes of your understanding, enabling you to know the hope of His calling and the riches of His inheritance, inspiring you to live a transcendent life of glory. (Ephesians 1:17-18; 2 Corinthians 3:18)

Pray that this year you are rooted and grounded deeply in Christ, firmly established in faith and continually abounding with thanksgiving. (Colossians 2:6-7)

Thank God for frustrating every satanic plan to bring shame, disrepute, or scandal against Apostle Justice Kwawu, his family, and the ministry. (Isaiah 54:17; Psalm 125:1-2)

Pray for the continued manifestation of the EWG Global covenant, asking God to elevate it to higher dimensions of impact and influence. (Deuteronomy 29:9; Psalm 89:34)

Ask God to endow us with unique gifts, talents, and divine solutions, enabling us to make global impact for His name's sake. (1 Corinthians 12:4-7; Matthew 5:16)

Declare that this is your season to arise and shine, for your light has come and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you; your destiny shines like the noonday. (Isaiah 60:1; Matthew 4:16; Matthew 5:14)

Pray for the restoration of every good thing lost in your destiny—strength, anointing, gifts, finances, grace, courage, favour, joy, and peace. (Joel 2:25; Isaiah 58:12)

Declare that you soar above challenges and obstacles by the power of the Spirit, declaring that you rise on the wings of the Spirit to fulfil God's purpose. (Isaiah 40:31; Zechariah 4:6)

Thank God for the life of Apostle Justice Kwawu, for the work He is doing through him, and for all pastors and leaders in EWG Global. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18; Hebrews 13:7)



DAY 5 FAVOUR

Thank God for His daily leading, guidance, and divine direction over EWG as a Church and a commission. Declare that our path shines brighter and brighter unto the perfect day. (Proverbs 3:5-6; Proverbs 4:18; Psalm 32:8)

Thank the Lord for the new things He has begun to do in your life this year. Thank Him also for the old doors He has closed, severing you from past limitations, cycles, and seasons that no longer align with His purpose. (Isaiah 43:18-19; 2 Peter 1:3-4; Revelation 3:7)

Declare that this year you experience favour which causes accelerated favour for promotion and elevation. You are lifted beyond natural timelines. (Psalm 75:6-7).

- **Accelerated favour for property acquisition;** houses and possessions you did not labour for come into my hands by covenant. (Deuteronomy 6:10-11).
- **Accelerated favour for preferential treatment;** you are distinguished by an excellent spirit. (Daniel 6:3)
- **Accelerated favour for granted petitions;** requests are answered speedily and doors open willingly. (Esther 5:8)
- **Accelerated favour that causes unfavourable policies and decisions** to be reversed on behalf of God's people. (Esther 5:2; Proverbs 21:1)
- **Accelerated favour for divine protection;** favour shields me from evil strategies and causes danger to be averted. (Psalm 5:12; Psalm 91:10)

Declare that God's favour on you attracts helpers of destiny, divinely positioned men and women who advance God's purpose in your life. (Isaiah 45:3; Ruth 2:10-12)

Declare that the favour of God on you causes you to enjoy ease in your labour, where grace multiplies effort and results exceed strength. (Psalm 127:1-2; Zechariah 4:6)

Affirm that you have been made me a wonder to your generation. You have been equipped for a life of unending success through the power of the Holy Spirit at work in you. (Psalm 71:7; Psalm 119:130)

Thank God for giving you all things richly to enjoy, for supplying all your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Thank God for a glorious life filled with joy, peace, laughter, and contentment. (1 Timothy 6:17; Philippians 4:19; Romans 14:17)

Declare that you are reigning in life by the power of the Holy Spirit, that God's divine power has already given you all things that pertain to life and godliness. You do not lack, struggle, or fail—because you operate from a place of divine sufficiency and supernatural enablement. (Romans 5:17; 2 Peter 1:3)

Declare that by the glorious life you have in Christ, the power of the Holy Spirit is at work in you, energising your spirit, renewing your mind, and producing tangible progress in every area of your life. (Romans 8:11; Philippians 2:13)

Declare that you have become a distributor of eternal truths to everyone in your world. Through you, light shines, faith is stirred, and lives are transformed. (2 Corinthians 4:6; Matthew 5:14)

Affirm that your faith is the victory that overcomes the world; therefore, nothing is impossible unto you. You live victoriously today because you live in the Word, by the Word, and through the Word. You have taken hold of my victorious life in Christ Jesus. (1 John 5:4; Mark 9:23; Colossians 2:6-7)



DAY 6 FAMILY

Thank God for being the Creator and Ordainer of families, for it is from Him that every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, identity, and purpose. (Ephesians 3:14-15)

Thank God for His wisdom in instituting the family, as a place of love, nurture, instruction, and the transmission of faith from generation to generation. (Genesis 2:18; Deuteronomy 6:6-7)

Thank God for placing you in a family by His divine design, knowing that you were not born by accident but positioned according to His purpose. (Psalm 68:6; Acts 17:26)

Command that every ungodly pattern, cycle, and limitation operating in your family line comes to a permanent end. Decree that the enemy will no longer have victory, access, or legal ground in your family.

Declare that your children will not fight the same battles nor confront the same giants you faced. (Colossians 2:14-15; Revelation 12:11; Isaiah 54:17)

Declare that God establishes every family in His divine order, that Christ is the foundation and love, honour, and understanding govern every relationship. (Psalm 127:1; Colossians 3:14-15).

Pray for peace to rule in every marriage, that strife, confusion, and division give way to harmony, mutual respect, and unity of purpose. (Isaiah 32:18; James 3:17-18)

Pray for love and forgiveness to abound in families, that hearts are healed, offences are released, and relationships are restored by grace. (Ephesians 4:31-32; 1 Corinthians 13:4-7)

Pray that the presence of the Holy Spirit rests upon families, guiding decisions, strengthening love, and empowering godly living. (Romans 8:14; John 14:16-17)

Pray for the salvation of entire households, declaring that every member of the family comes to the knowledge of Christ and walks in truth. (Acts 16:31; Joshua 24:15)

We declare victory over miscarriages. By the authority of God's Word, obliterate the root and cause of miscarriages—whether spiritual or physical—in your life and family. Decree that none shall miscarry or be barren in the land. Command every devourer assigned against fruitfulness to be rebuked and destroyed. (Exodus 23:26; Malachi 3:10-12)

Declare that every conception shall be fruitful, viable, and productive, carried to full term and celebrated with joy. (Psalm 127:3; Isaiah 66:9)

Ask God for the Spirit of mercy and compassion to rest upon all our sisters trusting God for the fruit of the womb. Lift a cry of mercy and faith, calling forth the sound of a baby's cry into their homes. (Psalm 113:9; Mark 1:41; Luke 7:12-13)

Ask the Lord to reveal and purge every behavioural pattern, mindset, or character flaw that may have hindered marriages. We declare grace for transformation and maturity. (Psalm 139:23-24; 2 Corinthians 5:17)

Take authority over every enchantment, divination, delay, or demonic resistance working against marriages. We annul, cancel, and disarm every such operation. (Numbers 23:23; Colossians 1:13-14)

Declare liberty; wherever your wife or husband is, command them to be loosed and aligned with God's timing and purpose. (John 8:36)



DAY 7 Guidance

Dear Father, I thank You for the guidance of Your Spirit in my life and for the wisdom You impart to me daily. I am continually yielded to the Lordship of Your Word; therefore, my steps are ordered in victory, success, and excellence. I walk by faith and not by sensory perception. I live from my spirit, and the circumstances of life are subdued before me. (Psalm 37:23; Proverbs 3:5-6; 2 Corinthians 5:7)

I live on God's terms. I reason with the mind of Christ, and my outlook on life is shaped by the perspective of the Word. I live in power and work miracles as I live in and through the Holy Spirit and the Word today, in Jesus' Name. Amen. (1 Corinthians 2:16; Mark 16:17; John 14:12)

I affirm that this is my season of direction. My spirit is receptive to the Word, and my mind is anointed to think excellent thoughts. I have an inward guide, and I am continually inspired by the Word to think on things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of good report. (Isaiah 30:21; Philippians 4:8; Romans 8:14)

The Word of God is building my faith strong and exposing me to the realities of the Kingdom. My faith will never fail, nor will it rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power and truth of God. (Romans 10:17; 1 Corinthians 2:5)

By the Spirit, I lay hold of my inheritance in Christ. I walk in divine health, prosperity, favour, and victory. My life moves only upward and forward because the Father has chosen and ordained me to be productive in every area of life. (Ephesians 1:11; Deuteronomy 28:13; John 15:16)

My mind is anointed for growth and supernatural accomplishment. The eyes of my spirit are enlightened to see the right opportunities, and I am positioned to eat of the good of the land. (Ephesians 1:18; Isaiah 1:19)

I know what to do, when to do it, and how to do it—by the guidance and light of the Holy Spirit and the Word. I am making progress and winning every day by the power of the Spirit at work in me mightily. Glory to God. Hallelujah! (Isaiah 48:17; Philippians 2:13)

I affirm that my spirit, soul, and body are fully yielded to the leading of the Holy Spirit. I am not ordinary, for God is at work in me, both to will and to do of His good pleasure. I am never disadvantaged, for the favour of the Lord is at work in me in increasing measure. (Romans 12:1; Philippians 2:13; Psalm 84:11)

I have direction for life. The Word of God is in my heart and in my mouth, and as I speak it forth, every crooked path is made straight. (Romans 10:8-10; Isaiah 45:2)

We declare that we are divinely directed by the Spirit of God, and our feet are guided away from error. (Isaiah 30:21)

We receive grace to stand perfect and complete in all the will of God, lacking in nothing. (Colossians 4:12)

DAY 8 LEADERSHIP & GLOBAL COMMISSION

Pray that God's Servant is single-minded and unwavering in the pursuit of the growth mandate, focused, disciplined, and strengthened to fulfil every divine assignment without distraction.

(Acts 20:24; Philippians 3:13-14)

Pray that the whole counsel of God is preached fully through God's Servant, with clarity, power, balance, and accuracy, bringing light, conviction, and transformation to many.

(Acts 20:27; 2 Timothy 4:2)

Pray that God delivers His Servant from every trap of the enemy, and from wicked and unreasonable men, preserving his life, voice, and ministry.

(2 Thessalonians 3:2; Psalm 121:7-8)

Pray for every leader God has ordained to stand with His Servant and EWG, that they are strengthened, aligned, faithful, and effective in their assignments.

(Exodus 17:12; Nehemiah 4:6)

Pray that God opens our eyes to truly know His Servant, enabling us to follow with understanding and become partakers of the grace and anointing upon his life.

(Hosea 12:13; Hebrews 13:7)

Pray that God prospers the work of the hands of the leadership, granting success, wisdom, and fruitfulness in all responsibilities. (Psalm 90:17; Deuteronomy 28:8)

Pray a covering of blessing and protection over the families of leaders, pastors, HODs, and workforce, declaring peace, health, and preservation.

(Psalm 91:1-2; Isaiah 54:17)

Thank God for frustrating every satanic counsel of misfortune, calamity, and premature death targeted against associate pastors, HODs, and the entire workforce. (Psalm 33:10-11; Isaiah 28:18)

Thank God for exceptional creativity, innovation, and divine ideas resting upon all associate pastors, HODs, and the workforce, enabling excellence and impact.

(Exodus 35:31-32; Daniel 1:17)

Thank God for oneness of mind, spirit, soul, and body, and for love and peace to advance the vision and mission of EWG Global to the next level.

(Acts 4:32; Psalm 133:1-3)

Thank God for His covenant of protection and blessing upon Apostle Justice Kwawu (AJK) and his family, declaring that His covenant shall not be broken.

(Psalm 89:34; 1 Corinthians 15:57)

By the authority in the name of Jesus, pray for the restoration of every good thing lost—strength, anointing, spiritual gifts, finances, grace, courage, boldness, honour, favour, joy, and peace. (Joel 2:25; Isaiah 58:12)

Declare that in this year, the message of this commission goes throughout all the cities of the world, gaining worldwide influence.

(Psalm 19:3-4; Matthew 24:14)

Declare that the doors of the nations are opened, and that there is no speech or language where our voice will not be heard. (Revelation 3:8; Isaiah 60:11)



DAY 9 THE UNSAVED, UNCOMMITTED & UNCHURCHED

Pray that every member growing into full alignment with the vision of the commission receives clarity, understanding, and conviction of purpose. Declare that as they attend our services, they experience the manifest Presence of God, and that this encounter produces lasting fruit and establishment this year.

(Habakkuk 2:2; Colossians 2:6-7; Psalm 26:8)

Pray that God stirs a deep hunger for growth, direction, and spiritual insight in the hearts of people even before they come into our services.

Declare that divine longing draws them deliberately and expectantly.

Pray for grace to be separated unto Christ for unlimited and ever-increasing revelation of His person, His power, and His purposes. Ask for insight into the revelation of Christ's mission in your life, in the Church, and in this generation. (Philippians 3:8-10; Colossians 1:26-27)

Ask for understanding of the glory of Christ that is to come, so that your hope is secured and steadfast regardless of present challenges. Declare that your expectation is anchored in eternal realities, not temporary pressures. (Romans 8:18; Hebrews 6:19; 2 Corinthians 4:17-18)

Thank God that your life is continually upgraded by the power of God's Word. The entrance of God's Word into your spirit has brought direction, clarity, and purpose. I walk in the light of life and function in higher realms of glory. (Psalm 119:130; John 8:12)

Affirm that you are conscious of God's abundant provisions for you, and enjoy them fully because you see by the light of His Word. Declare that you are backed by God to rule and dominate your world through the Word of faith that is in your heart and in your mouth. As you speak, results are produced and promises are obtained. (Romans 10:8-10; Mark 11:23)

Confess that you are seated together with Christ, far above principalities, powers, and all dominion. Your body is a manifestation of God's glory. You are strengthened with might by the Spirit and fortified with divine energy. (Ephesians 2:6; Ephesians 3:16)

Affirm that you live with a daily consciousness of your divine life in Christ. Jesus Christ is Lord of your life. You have been crucified with Christ; nevertheless, you live—yet not you, but Christ lives in you. (Galatians 2:20; Colossians 1:27)

Heavenly Father, how gracious and loving You are to me. Thank You for making my body the dwelling place of Your Spirit. I am strengthened with might in my inner man as the anointing flows through every fibre of my being, making me sickness-free and sound. (Ephesians 3:16; Psalm 92:10)

Thank You Father for making Your Word available to me. I take full advantage of the ministry of the Holy Spirit who teaches me the Word as I study. I am built up by the Word to live a life of success, victory, promotion, and excellence—dealing wisely in all affairs of life. (John 14:26; Acts 20:32; Joshua 1:8)

Pray for grace to lay aside malice, guile, hypocrisy, envy, and evil speaking. Pray for a renewed and increased hunger for the pure Word of God, that you may grow thereby. (1 Peter 2:1-2; Psalm 119:103) Declare all-round peace all year round. No plague, calamity, destruction, or terror shall come near our dwellings. We dwell in safety, quietness, and confidence. (Isaiah 32:18; Psalm 91:10-11)

Dear Father, I thank You for the blood of Jesus that has washed me clean and brought me into union and fellowship with You. Through the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ, I stand holy, blameless, sanctified, and irreproachable in Your sight. (Colossians 1:21-22; Hebrews 10:22)

Because Jesus took my place and gave me His own life, sickness and disease have no legal right in my body. I live a healthy, successful, and victorious life. Failure has no association with me. (Isaiah 53:5; Galatians 2:20)



DAY 14 Church Growth & Increase 1/2

We pray for the abundant supply of the Spirit of God upon every church worker—the choristers, ushers, guides, protocol, media teams, and all service officials. Declare that they serve with joy, excellence, wisdom, and supernatural efficiency, strengthened inwardly by the Spirit to fulfil their assignments flawlessly.

We pray that by virtue of the Spirit at work through our workers and officials, everyone who attends our services is inspired, positioned, and prepared to receive from God.

(Ephesians 1:17-19; Ephesians 3:14-20; Colossians 1:9-12)

We pray that every segment of our services in 2026 ministers' life whether through in-person gatherings, social media, radio, livestreams, or digital platforms—reaching people across the world with transforming power. Declare that no service is routine; every gathering releases divine life and impact. (John 6:63; Acts 2:46-47)

Declare that the veil covering hearts is removed, the covering cast is broken, and Christ is received in the hearts of the people. (2 Corinthians 4:4; Psalm 2:8; Galatians 4:19; Colossians 4:12)

We pray that doors of utterance are opened in every nation—granting boldness, clarity, and unrestricted proclamation of the Gospel. Declare that the Word grows, multiplies, and prevails. (Ephesians 6:19; Acts 12:24; Acts 6:7; Acts 19:20)

Father, back the Gospel we preach with signs, wonders, miracles, and healings.

We pray that You prosper men and women and cause them to give generously for the advancement of the Gospel. (Acts 4:29–33; Acts 5:12; Acts 9:32–35; Zechariah 1:17)

We declare that our entrance into the above nations is opened to EWG Global. The Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ thrives in these lands.
